

Afterschool Program at Living Fountain

Kampong Speu, Cambodia

LF currently has an afterschool program designed for both the children of LF and Kampong Speu. Offered classes include: English, Khmer, and Mathematics. Classes take place daily and are organized into various levels.

Afterschool Program Instructor – Volunteer Position

Description:

- Instruct English classes daily M-F, mostly at beginner level
- Curriculum and evaluation provided
- Report grades and results to director
- On-site housing provided

Volunteering at LF means:

- Participating in the daily routines of LF, including: Morning staff devotion, Wednesday night service, and Sunday worship
- To be an assistance to staff and directors outside of teaching hours
- To remain flexible and show support for missionaries

Job requirements:

- Over 18 years of age and baptized and/or confirmed
- Active member of CoaH for at least 1 year or of another church
- Able to commit minimum 3 months in Cambodia (6 months to 1 year is preferred)
- Experience serving in church ministries and/or working with children and youth (Note: We may request a Vulnerable Sector Police Check)
- Experience teaching English, math, music, sports is an asset
- Good communication skills and experience working in a team
- Display Christ-like character and a positive attitude when performing tasks
- Open to learning basic Khmer and comfortable with the challenges of a language barrier
- Comfortable living on your own (e.g. cooking for yourself, cleaning, etc.)

To submit:

- ⑦ CoaH Missions Application Form
- ⑦ Two reference letters one must be from a senior or lead pastor
- \$100 deposit made payable to "Young Nak Presbyterian Church" (applicant's name & "mid-term missions" in the memo section)
- Once forms and documents are submitted, you will start missions training with either a Short Term Team (if timing coincides) or with Pastor Tim Song

Finances:

- Monthly aid from CoaH is provided once application has been approved
- Round-trip airfare (approximately \$1,700-\$2,000)
- Food cost (breakfast and dinner, lunch is \$1/day with children)
- Fundraising is encouraged (ideas can be provided by previous mid-term members)
- Consider making a budget outline for review
- Visa costs:
 - Visitor's Visa (30 days) \$30 USD
 - Visa Renewal (1 month to 1 year) available prices depend on duration (each month is approx. \$30 USD)
- Health insurance highly recommended
- Extra cost for touring, souvenirs, emergencies, etc.
